







Regulations for sculptors accepted as participants at the 11th International Obernkirchen Sculptor Symposium. July 30—August 12 2018

- The 11th International Obernkirchen Sculptor Symposium will take place in 2018. Approximately ten artists from all over the world will be working with the world famous obernkirchen sandstone. The working place will be on the church square.
- Travel expenses economy class will be refunded by the organizer, "Internationales Obernkirchener Bildhauer-Symposium e.V." (also IOBS e.V.). The IOBS e.V. offers free accommodation within Obernkirchen families. Breakfast and lunch are free on working days.
- Lunch will be served on the church place and we can promise you a good and rich but light and fresh meal.
- The IOBS e.V. will will provide you with the "Obernkirchen sandstone" needed for your work. Broken sandstone blocks in different sizes (maximal weight 2 tons, or 1 cubic meter incl. socket) are available. You should notice that the Obernkirchen sandstone is very hard! The artist must bring his own tools.
- Electrical grinding machines (Flex) will only be allowed from 7 am 9 am, which must be strictly adhered to (Please take notice!!). A High capacity compressor for compressed air utensils as well as electricity connections are available on place. Further on the artist must bring his own tools. Sculptors working traditionally artisanal will be preferred!
- The sculpture created during the symposium becomes property of the artist. The artist agrees to leave the sculpture in Obernkirchen for at least two years, unless the sculpture is sold. The final placement and care of the sculpture will be carried out by the town of Obernkirchen. If a sculpture is sold or collected the artist will be responsible for transportation costs.
- The artist and the Board of the International Obernkirchen Sculptor Symposium (IOBS) agree that the IOBS may take Photos / digital prints of the artists work for non commercial publication in print, web or similar.

Parallel to the symposium a (sales) exhibition will take place in a very inspiring location.

If a sculpture is sold, the organizer receives 20 % of the sales price.

Each artist will receive 60 euro per working day.

The artist must have a valid health insurance as well as an accident insurance.

Only applications with detailed information on paper will be considered.

Please include a sketch of ideas for your work at the symposium.

Digital applications will not be accepted.
